How to Use

Children search for signs of spring, flowers, and nature inspired by cherry blossom season.

This activity can be used:

- outdoors in a park or garden
- during a spring nature walk
- alongside a lesson about Hanami or seasonal change

Best for

- KS1 – Lower KS2
- Ages 5–9
